



Activity: ZEV 3-2-1

A survey done by Natural Resources Canada found that many Canadians lack knowledge about zero-emission vehicles, which is a huge barrier to the increased use of ZEVs. Use the 3-2-1 method to summarize the learnings around zero-emission vehicles from the other Zero-Emission Vehicles and Low-Carbon Driving resources (or further research that may have been done using sources referenced in the other resources).



Record 3-2-1:

- 3 facts or things learned from the lesson or text,
- 2 questions remaining, and
- 1 main idea.



Small group sharing

Depending on the size of the group, after recording the 3-2-1, students can gather into small groups and discuss what they wrote.



Whole group discussion

After small group discussions, students can gather as a whole group and discuss.

Extend the learning:

- Share these 3 facts and/or 1 main idea with the broader school community.
- Conduct further research on the questions remaining.

Adaptations

- Depending on the age group and group size, students can also complete this activity in small groups.
- All answers can be collected by having students record their answers on sticky notes to post on a white board, chart paper, or virtual platform such as *Jamboard* or *Miro*.
