Certification Process 2023-24

School Board/District-operated Outdoor and Environmental Education Centres (OEECs) provide experiential opportunities for students that are pivotal in fostering environmental learning and active engagement. EcoSchools hopes to frame our relationships with OEECs as partnerships, where OEECs and EcoSchools staff can collaborate to support schools using the EcoSchools framework.



) Certification Process

Step 1: Register your OEEC using the OEEC Certification Form. This form should be completed by one staff member from your centre. See pages 2 and 3 for an outline of what to expect on the form.

Step 2: Support the partnership aspects of this certification model by participating in four engagement activities of your choice such as:

- Coordinating and hosting community hub meetings for teachers in your board/district
- Creating locally-relevant resources that enhance and/or support school certification efforts
- Acting as a liaison for regional community organizations that can support school certification efforts
- Presenting at student and/or teacher conferences with links to the EcoSchools program
- Hosting workshops or webinars for teachers and/or students with links to the EcoSchools program
- Visiting schools to provide on-site support for environmental learning and campaigns linked to the EcoSchools program
- Fostering opportunities for nature connection and environmental learning within the broader community, including families and the public (e.g., leading nature hikes, building local species lists, creating a tracking club, hosting a public event, etc.)
- Deepening knowledge through regular professional development opportunities for OEEC staff
- Utilizing communication channels (e.g., Twitter, Facebook, etc.) or online tools to support ongoing learning for visiting students and/or staff and that support school certification efforts

Step 3: After completing your four engagement activities, return to the OEEC Certification Form to describe activities and upload supporting documentation (e.g., photos, brochures, minutes, agendas, workshop outlines, etc.) demonstrating that the selected activities have occurred.

Step 4: Submit your completed OEEC Certification Form by the second Friday in May (May 10, 2023).



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D Assessment, Recognition, and Support

- OEECs will not be certified via a point system but are part of a certified/not-certified assessment.
- Certified OEECs will receive a certification seal and digital recognition in June
- Invitations to attend professional development sessions with EcoSchools (e.g., EcoSchools conferences, webinars, etc.)
- Ongoing access to EcoSchools staff to provide feedback, offer suggestions, and troubleshoot challenges
