This template can be used to document one species at a time. To complete the template for additional species:

- **On a tablet or other device:** open the original file again. Remember to save each unique copy of the document.
- **On paper:** print multiple copies of this document and complete it by hand.

Species Name: Use your field guide, plant-identification app, reference sheet, and/or knowledge to identify the species being observed. You can do more research to double-check or change the name later!

Species Type: Is this a special species?

Species Count: How many of these species can you find and count?

Habitat: Describe the place where you found the species. You might note the amount of water, sunlight, soil texture, nearness to other species, or anything else!

Sketch: Try to show what the species looks like so you can easily do more research later!
